



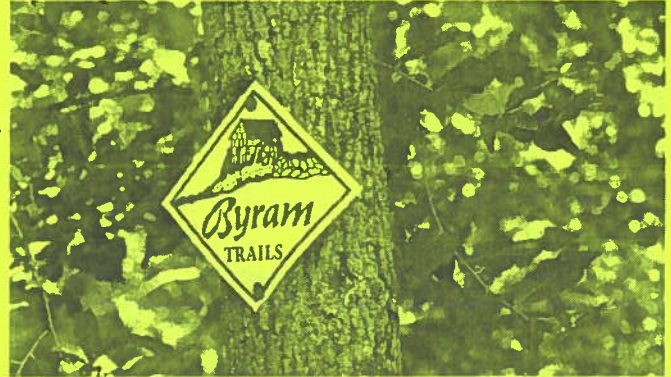
## Byram Township Parks and Recreation

# Second Saturday Hikes and one First Saturday

Second Saturday Hikes highlight various trails in Byram Township. The hikes are open to families with children as well as avid hikers. Groups may begin together and spread out along the trail to meet different hikers needs and abilities. Please wear appropriate footwear and bring water.

**Sat June 3 National Trails Day Hike - Sussex Branch Trail. Check out the spring flowers and see if the beavers have been busy.**

- 9:00 am start
- Relatively flat and easy terrain
- Approximately 1.5 - 2 miles out and the same distance back
- Start Location: Sussex Branch Parking lot on Waterloo Rd across from Continental Drive



**Sat June 10 Tamarack Park Opening Day - Tamarack Park. Celebrate the opening of a new park and trail. Ribbon Cutting held, June 9, 6:00 pm.**

- 9:00 am start
- Easy/moderate terrain
- Approximately 1.6 miles each direction
- Start Location: Tamarack Park athletic fields, 10 Jones Lane, just off Rt. 206

**Sat. July 8 Independence Hike - Jefferson Glen Bike Path - Celebrate our early presidents and America's Independence. It's a Red, White and Blue kind of week.**

- 9:00 am start
- Easy/Moderate difficulty
- 2 miles out and 2 miles back
- Start location: Take Hi-Glen Dr across from Shoprite Plaza all the way to the end (road name changes to Louis, then Drexel). Park in the cul-de-sac at the end of Drexel Dr.

**Sat Aug 12 Summer Heat Hike - Cat Swamp, Jefferson Glen, Sussex Branch, and Cat Swamp - Hangin' with the Cool Cats in the Swamp. If you don't have cat ears, wear bright sun orange. Bring your cat-like reflexes to climb over the rocks.**

- 9:00 am start
- Moderate difficulty
- Approximately 3-mile loop
- Start location: Back parking lot of Salt Gastropub

**Sat Sept 9 Byram Day Run/Walk - Mansfield Bike Path - Walk or run and enjoy the festival afterwards. Check out food vendors, free inflatable rides, touch-a-truck, demonstrations and music at the festival. Look for Mario Brothers at this event.**

- 10:15 am start, 9:30 - 10:00 registration
- Easy/moderate terrain. All-terrain strollers are welcome
- Approximately 3 miles (5K)
- Start location: Park at the Byram Schools parking lot. Walk to Neil Gylling Park for registration

**Sat Oct 14 Fall Foliage Hike - Tamarack Park, pass Johnson Lake to Cranberry Overlook.**

**Check out the fall foliage as you look down over Cranberry Lake and towards the Delaware Water Gap. Bring a snack to enjoy at the top while you enjoy the view. Fall colors are the way to go.**

- 9:00 am start
- Moderate/difficult terrain
- 1.7 miles up and 1.7 miles back
- Start Location: Park at Tamarack Park parking lots. Walk to trail head across the fields at the far end of Tamarack Park
